Dear First Family and Friends,


Have you read the book of Jude lately? It is a relative short book, only 25 verses. Presumably, Jude was the half-brother of Jesus, coming to faith following Jesus' resurrection and ascension. I believe this short book has some timely admonitions for us today.

Jude writes to challenge the true believers to "contend" for the faith. His word actually means to fight for, to agonize over, to compete for as to win a prize. The reason this challenge comes to the church is that "others" one translation uses "ungodly" people have wormed their way into the church and are teaching falsehoods. Their main teaching is that because of God's amazing grace we can live however, immoral lives we want.

Jude gives us six challenges to strengthen us in contending for the faith. We are to "build each other up" "pray in the power of the Holy Spirit" "await the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ" "keep yourself safe in God's love" "show mercy on those who doubt, even those who are unrepentant" and "snatching others just in the nick of time."
