I have found that more often than not, Christians lack the confidence to engage our culture on uncomfortable issues that require a solid Biblical position. David Platt's Counter Culture, addresses an array of concerns ranging from poverty and sex slavery to same-sex marriage, racism, pornography, and immigration. Along the way, he also deals with persecution, orphans, and abortion. We must have these issues "worked out" in our hearts and minds or we will fall dumbfounded when we are confronted by them. This study is a wonderful opportunity to be grounded in a Biblical worldview that will elevate the Gospel as our, "prepared defense to anyone who asks (us) for a reason for the hope that is in (us); yet to do it with gentleness and respect," (1Peter 3:15) Please pick, join and faithfully attend, one of these studies.
