Safety Tidbits

During and after this year's VBS (July 11th-14th), a series of vandalism and littering incidences occurred in and near the children's playground area. Lamar's police responded twice to the discovery of vandalism and to a second such attack, with another episode of littering taking place between police visits. Thankfully nobody suffered any type of injury with a multi-tool that includes a knife being found on the platform that services a slide, by one of our youngsters. Littering was not contained to the play area alone and included aluminum cans and cigarette butts. The gate, a section of fence, a plastic chair and a bench made of metal and wood were the victims of vandalism. The chair and bench became scrap. Two of our members stepped up as one repaired the fence and gate while installing a warning sign and the other donated and installed a wireless camera that has a view of the gate, some of the fence and parking lot. We notified the other local churches and fortunately, they did not report any incidents to their property.
