Safety Tidbits

Wet Weather Safety Driving Tips

- 1. Thank God for the rain and ask for a shield of protection while on the road.
- 2. Check for proper tire inflation when they are cold.
- 3. Check tires for adequate tread depth. Using a quarter, insert Washington's head into a groove, if you can see above his head, it is probably time for replacements.
- 4. Avoid using cruise control on wet/slipperv pavement, if you lose traction the cruise control will continue on at the set speed until cancelled, potentially taking you on a hazardous unwanted detour.
- 5. Slow down, giving yourself more distance and time to maneuver to avoid hazards and abrupt braking or turning in reaction to them.
- 6. When it is raining drive in the tracks left by the vehicle in front of you, taking advantage of them clearing some of the standing water present on the road surface.
- 7. Verify that all of the lights on your vehicle are operational, and then use them when driving.
- 8. Replace worn out/dried out wiper blades especially if they don't clear the windshield cleanly or leave streaks.
- 9. Now that you know how to drive in Wet Weather, PRAY FOR RAIN!!


