They are the sons God has given me here," Joseph said to his father. Then Israel said, "Bring them to me so I may bless them. Genesis 48:9

Give them a chance, for Christ created grandkids to be objects of their grandparents' affection and blessing. Encourage your children to visit the home of your parents, and trust God to unleash His blessing through your parents. Their unconditional love makes your child a better son or daughter and you, a better parent.

Grandparents, bless your grandchildren with a legacy of love for God and people. Do not become the center of attention; instead lead them to fall in love with Jesus.
