Safety Tidbits

Winter time home safety tips

- 1. Check your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors for proper operation.
- 2. Check all air filters once a month and replace as needed.
- 3. Close all crawl space vents.
- 4. Have any chimneys or vents on heating equipment inspected and cleaned.
- 5. Insulate all non-frost proof exterior water faucets and store all garden hoses.
- 6. Keep a clear area around heating equipment and flammables like candles.
- 7. Consider obtaining a backup heating source.
- 8. Purchase or compile a "Bug Out" kit of essential items (food, clothing, medicines) you would need to survive for a 72-hour isolation/transition period and don't forget any pets.
- 9. During freezing temperatures leave faucets running with a trickle of water, especially if you have concerns over night and during absences.
- 10. Spread sand or kitty litter on icy walk ways.
