

First Hand Faith

Lamentations 3:22-23

22 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; **23** they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

Our youth just finished up a bible study on first hand faith. To be honest with you I went into the study thinking I was pretty solid in my faith, but I soon realized I have some work to do myself. As adults, we sometimes get too comfortable in our faith and forget that an ongoing relationship with God takes continual work and effort. I was reminded of the old saying that "you can't stay were you are and go with God". It is very easy to find a comfortable place in our relationship with God and just hang out there. We all like comfortable and safe places. Don't we? My question for you today is, are you just hanging out in a safe place with God? Does your relationship still have that fresh and new feeling? First hand faith should have a fresh and new feeling. Do you remember the feeling you had when you first got saved? That newness tends to fade when we stay in our comfort zone and quit putting work into the relationship. That work comes through bible study, prayer, and gathering with other believers to encourage each other.

In courts of law, a first-person witness is always preferred. The testimony of one who was there, saw it, heard it, and remembers and believes is a powerful witness. So too in matters of faith. Second-person faith is good. For instance, "You know God will help you," Third-person faith is also good. For example, "They know the Lord will bless them." But, however good they may be, second and third-person faith are not enough. Faith in God, on the first-hand level is essential now and will be increasingly so in days to come. There are several principles we can rely on to keep our first hand faith fresh and new.

Principle 1: Developing first-hand faith in God refers to a process. (Sanctification) Growing closer each day. Principle 2: Developing first-hand faith in God requires per-

sonal involvement. Putting in the work.

Principle 3: Developing first-hand faith in God involves remembering who Jesus is always!

Principle 4: Developing first-hand faith in God matures into doubt not, fear not, only trust and believe.
