**Safety Tidbits**

Electrical Safety & fire prevention

1. Regularly check all electrical devices and appliances to be sure they are functioning properly. Overheating, sparks, smoking, failing to operate and electrical shocks all indicate a problem.
2. Inspect all cords and replace any that are frayed, dried out or damaged.
3. Turn off and unplug items, especially heat producing units like space heaters and hot plates when not in use.
4. When not in use unplug chargers i.e.: cell phones and hand tools.
5. Do not alter three prong plugs or use adapters in two-slotted outlets.
6. Do not overload circuits. Is a breaker tripping quite often? It is either worn out or the circuit is overloaded.
7. If you need to use an extension cord, verify it is rated for your desired use.

Do not use the area in front of electrical main panels for storage.
