SERMON NOTES

Safety Tidbits

Electrical Safety & fire prevention

- 1. Regularly check all electrical devices and appliances to be sure they are functioning properly. Overheating, sparks, smoking, failing to operate and electrical shocks all indicate a problem.
- 2. Inspect all cords and replace any that are frayed, dried out or damaged.
- 3. Turn off and unplug items, especially heat producing units like space heaters and hot plates when not in use.
- 4. When not in use unplug chargers i.e.: cell phones and hand tools.
- 5. Do not alter three prong plugs or use adapters in twoslotted outlets.
- 6. Do not overload circuits. Is a breaker tripping quite often? It is either worn out or the circuit is overloaded.
- 7. If you need to use an extension cord, verify it is rated for your desired use.

Do not use the area in front of electrical main panels for storage.
