CHILD Summer Safety Tidbits

3. Sun exposure:
Use sunscreen, sunglasses w/ 99% UV protection, wear light loose, tight weaved clothing. Keep small children out of direct sunlight.

4. When at the pool or swimming hole: Supervise them when swimming. Equip them with proper flotation devices for thier age and size. Teach them to swim as early as possible.

5. Fire safety:
Never let small kids light or play with fireworks. Keep a supply of water near by.
Never light a fireworks that did not go off, dispose of it properly. Supervise the roasting of marshmallows around the camp fire.
