Six months ago, I overheard part of a road rage incident directed at a female who allegedly pulled out in front of a very vulgar, agitated, unforgiving male.

There was not a collision, yet the offended male had to get out of his car while repeatedly yelling the same obscene vulgarities in which he addressed the other party as being a sexually active female.

The recipient of the abuse did drive off, fortunately the assailment did not follow.

Here are actions that police advise to take if faced with a similar or worse situation: lock your doors and roll up all windows, blare the horn to attract attention and help. Without a collision, if you can, drive off, if not call 911.

If you are being followed call 911 as you drive. If you know the locations of the local law enforcement offices or even a Fire Hall, drive towards them or at least to a populated area. And of course, as in any threatening situation in life, PRAY!
