

**SERMON NOTES**

**Safety Tips**

1. If you can hear thunder, you are in danger, lightning can travel as far as 10 miles from the area with rain.
2. If you are in an open area such as a park, athletic fields, open water, pond or river, start praying and leave immediately to seek cover.

Avoid the Following:

- A. Being the tallest object in the area where you are.
- B. Metal objects such as fencing, wires and utility poles.
- C. Sheltering in areas with concrete surfaces (the rebar within it can conduct electricity) such as a garage and patios.

Shelter preferably in a fully enclosed substantial building, a hard top fully enclosed vehicle with the windows closed or if caught outside an area of dense small trees surrounded by taller trees.
