Dear First Family and Friends,

Denise and I had the privilege of traveling with Bill and Judy Jetton, (OPBA Director of Missions), this past week to the Midwest Leadership Summit in Springfield, Illinois. I would not be able to share everything I experienced in those few days, but I did share with the deacons one take away from the conference. The last speaker of Thursday morning shared this truth.
