From the Pastor's Heart


Dear First Family and Friends,

Speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.

— Ephesians 4:15

When we walk with the Holy Spirit, we are changed. With the Spirit's help we can change the way we speak in our homes and workplaces, in our churches, and in the world. Simply relying on the Holy Spirit is the best way to communicate the truth to someone that needs to hear it.

A great prayer to voice before speaking to someone would be: Father, help me to choose my words well, building others up in faith rather than hurting and tearing down. May my words be attractive to all who don't yet know you as well. In Jesus name, Amen.
