At this time there are not any "storm shelter" signs posted, however all of the doors leading to shelter areas in the new building have 3 dead bolt locks on them and are on the ground floor in front of a anyone who walks directly south into the FLOC building. When fortified shelters are not available experts advise using a ground level room without windows or exterior doors such as restrooms and closets while avoiding large open areas such as the Fellowship Hall.
